

Blue Cluster Homework Program

The middle school years are critical in the academic lives of our students. In the Blue Cluster they will continue to develop their level of responsibility and work ethic. Completing quality work on time is essential to this development. In keeping with the Barrington Middle School Homework Guidelines, Blue Cluster teachers

- accept assignments that are completed on time and according to directions for full credit,
- accept assignments that are completed according to directions and submitted one day late for 50% credit,
- accept any assignments turned in during the quarter later than one day late for 25% credit, unless otherwise specified.

Students will have the obligation of turning in their homework on time every day. If an assignment is not turned in, a student will stay after school for Homework Period on the next school day (Monday through Thursday,) and will continue to stay after school each day until the work is made up. If a missing assignment is made up for 50% on the next day, then that student will not be required to stay after school on that day.

It is the student's responsibility to communicate the need to stay after school with her/his parents/guardians. Failure to stay after school will result in contact with the parent/guardian, and will result in an office disciplinary referral for repeat offenses.

The after school Homework Period will be for ½ hour, from dismissal at 2:05 until 2:35. Regardless of the type of homework, the meeting room for Homework Period will be

- Wednesdays in room 114 (Mr. Borgueta)
- Thursdays in room 207 (Mrs. Olchowski)
