

FIVE TYPES OF WRITING

Type One: Capture Ideas

Writing that gets ideas on paper - Brainstorming
Writing is timed with a minimum length given
Questions and/or guesses are permitted
One Draft

Type Two: Respond Correctly

Writing that demonstrates knowledge about a topic
Correct answer to a specific question
One Draft

Type Three: Edit for FCAs

Writing with substantive content that is self-edited
Writing completes assignment and is easy to read
Editing for FCAs and revisions are done on original
One Draft (Saved to Portfolio)

Type Four: Peer Edit for FCAs

Writing is a Type Three piece that is then peer edited
Writing is revised based on peer edit
Two Drafts (Both Saved to Portfolio)

Type Five: Publish

Writing is error free and of publishable quality
Multiple Drafts (All Saved to Portfolio)
