The Summer School program is offered to students of Barrington residents whose children attend grades 1-12.

The summer school program runs from Tuesday July 6<sup>th</sup> through August 5<sup>th</sup>. The first week of summer school will be scheduled from Tuesday 7/6 to Friday 7/9. Classes in grades 1 through 5 will be scheduled from 8:00 A.M. – 9:30 A.M. Elementary math will be offered Tuesday and Wednesday morning and elementary Language Arts will be offered Thursday and Friday morning. Classes in grades 6 through 11 will be scheduled from 8:00 A.M. – 9:30 A.M. and 9:45 A.M. – 11:15 A.M. and will meet Tuesday through Friday.

The following four weeks of summer school classes in grades 1 through 5 will be scheduled from 8:00 A.M. – 9:30 A.M. Elementary math will be offered Monday and Tuesday mornings and elementary Language Arts will be offered Wednesday and Thursday mornings. Classes in grades 6 through 11 will be scheduled from 8:00 A.M. – 9:30 A.M. and 9:45 A.M. – 11:15 A.M., and will meet four days a week (Monday through Thursday). The last day of the summer program will be on Thursday, August 5, 2010.

**All classes will be located at Barrington Middle School.**

Parents may register or drop off their registration forms for Summer School at Barrington Middle School or at the High School after May 25, 2010. The registration fee is \$60.00 per elementary class and \$120 per middle and high school class. Registration forms will also be available at all schools throughout the district. Students may have the opportunity to register for courses up to the morning of July 2<sup>nd</sup> based on class enrollment.

**Parents in grades 1 – 5 must enter the building to pick up their children.**

## **Eligibility**

High School students who have failed courses during the year may earn credits in summer school if the following conditions have been met:

1. The student is recommended by a school administrator or guidance counselor.
2. The student is eligible according to the district attendance policy.
3. Trigonometry or Computer Applications may be offered as a supplemental course; all other courses are offered for remedial help.

Students will not be registered until payment is received in full. No refunds will be made after the start of the summer program. Enrollment is based on a “first come first served” basis. The director has the option of canceling classes due to under enrolled courses.

## **Attendance**

Attendance is *mandatory*. Daily attendance will be taken and recorded. Excessive tardiness and unexcused absences will result in the student being dropped from the course and tuition forfeited. Absence due to illness must be reported to Caron Martin by 7:50 am. (247-3160)

## **Behavior**

Misbehavior will not be tolerated! The director can dismiss any student if discipline problems arise; tuition will be forfeited.

## **Transportation**

Parents/ guardians or students are responsible for transportation to and from school.
