Come and join us for a fantastic session of Chinese cooking. You will learn how to make dumpling, spring roll, fried rice, Lo Mien, and other delicious Chinese dishes.

Tuesdays Bring Nemo and Friends to School! Limit 10

Create a beautiful natural saltwater reef ecosystem in your school! Over a period of 8 weeks, we'll set up and maintain a 60 gallon "FINDING NEMO" hexagonal fish tank with animals that may include a small Nemo (clown fish) and anemone, Dory (blue tang), Jacque (cleaner shrimp), Gill (Moorish Idol), Peach (Marble Sea Star), Deb (Damsel fish) and Bubbles (yellow tang). You'll learn that this delicate ecosystem takes a while to sustain itself and fish cannot be added until several weeks after the saltwater, sand, "live" rock, snails and crabs control the nitrogen cycle. While creating the tank we'll use microscopes, chemical test kits, movie clips and more to learn about reef food webs, life cycles, water chemistry and marine conservation.
