## Rules and Expectations

*Sportsnight* is a fun night filled with games, sports, music and cartoons. Generally held monthly, *Sportsnight* is hosted by different clusters or clubs. Our first *Sportsnight* this year, hosted by the Silver Cluster, will be held on Friday, September 23<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 - 9:00 pm.

Only Barrington Middle School students are allowed to attend *Sportsnight* and dances.

Dear Student,

We want you to have an enjoyable time at *Sportsnight* but always remember your behavior toward chaperones, adults, and other students is a reflection upon you. You should act appropriately and respectfully at all times just as you do during the school day. Inappropriate or provocative dancing such as bumping, grinding, or forming human chains is not permitted. Similarly, you should not run, engage in horseplay, or engage in slamming behavior. Remember too, all school rules apply, especially our dress guidelines and our policy regarding the use of cell phones, texting, taking pictures or videotaping. If you need to contact a parent or guardian, simply inform Mr. Wheeler or Mrs. Parente, and they will show you where you can safely do so.

Finally, attending *Sportsnight* is a privilege that provides you with a great opportunity to meet others and make new friends. If you choose to violate any of the school rules stated in our *Student Handbook*, you will be removed from the dance and your parent/guardian will be contacted to pick you up immediately. Depending on the infraction, there may also be consequences when you return to school the following week. Barrington Middle School students are known for being responsible, respectful, and for being kind to others. By following a few simple rules we can all have an enjoyable time together!

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Unless otherwise directed, we ask that you drive into the circular driveway in front of the school building to drop off and pick up your child. Our doors will open at 7:00 pm and our event will conclude promptly at 9:00 pm.

For safety reasons, until 9:00 pm, students must remain inside the building. If you would like to pick your child up early, please come to the front door of the building. Also, we remind you children are not allowed to use cell phones in the school building. If you must contact your child via cell phone, please wait until our event has concluded and students are outside the building.

The cost of this event is \$5.00 per child. Scholarship money is available (just see Mr. Wheeler or Mrs. Parente). Refreshments will also be available for sale. From time to time, students may be asked to bring a canned good for donation to a worthy nonprofit organization. Please note, donations of canned goods or similar items are strictly voluntary.
